- 1 A Farnell WWI 'soldier' teddy bear, with golden mohair, black glass eyes, pipe-cleaner ears, swivel head and pin jointed limbs –3 ½in.(9cm.) high (some thinning); and another German bear with golden mohair, black boot button eyes, black stitched nose and mouth, fixed head, pin jointed limbs (bald)

- 2 A rare Farnell WWI 'soldier' Lucky Black Cat, with black mohair, green and black glass eyes, red stitched nose, felt ears, swivel head, pin-jointed limbs and tail –3 ½in.(9cm.) high (slight thinning)

- 3 A Farnell WWI 'soldier' Lucky Black Cat, with black mohair, yellow and black glass eyes, red stitched nose, felt ears, swivel head and pin-jointed limbs, whiskers and stump of tail –3 ½in.(9cm.) high (balding and fading); and a Schuco miniature red mohair bear (bald, missing hands)

- 4 An early Steiff cat rattle, circa 1904, of white felt, black boot button eyes, pink stitched nose and mouth, whiskers and tiny pin hole to ear, possibly from original button –3 ¾in. (9.5cm.) high (tail stitching loose)

- 5 An early lying velvet cat with pom-pom ball, circa 1908, of white and brown velvet, black boot button eyes, pink stitched nose and mouth, red ribbon and a white and red pom-pom ball between front paws –6in. (15.5cm.) long (stitch repairs to chest)

- 6 Two printed cloth cats, the smaller an Arnold Print Works of Massachusetts, circa 1900s, cut and sew cat –6 ½in. (16.5cm.) high (faded); and a Deans Rag Book Co. Ltd. printed kitten with green collar (restitched to lower back and top of tail, small hole to left hind left on seam)

- 7 An early Steiff seated velvet pointer dog, circa 1906, of white velvet with brown and black spotted details, black boot button eyes, black stitched nose and mouth and remains of ribbon –3 ¾in. (9.5cm.) high (tiny stitched repair to base of neck, slight thinning, two small stitch marks to base) - the two small stitch marks to base indicate that this could have been a pin cushion

- 8 An early Steiff seated felt pointer dog, circa 1904, of cream felt, with brown and black painted spots, black boot button eyes, possibly a black gutta percha nose, black stitched mouth and black collar –4in. (10cm.) high (some small nibbles, slight damage to ear, small holes under muzzle which have stitched down to collar, large hole to base, tail loose)

- 9 A fine and tiny Steiff velvet rabbit, circa 1906, with cream velvet with brown airbrushed patches, black bead eyes, pink stitched nose and mouth, original red ribbon with bell and tiny blank button –3in. (7.5cm.) long (slight discolouration to cream velvet)

- 10 A fine and tiny Steiff velvet rabbit, circa 1906, with cream velvet with brown airbrushed patches, black bead eyes, pink stitched nose and mouth, original red ribbon with bell and tiny blank button –3in. (7.5cm.) long (slight discolouration to cream velvet)

- 11 A fine and tiny Steiff velvet rabbit, circa 1906, with cream velvet with brown airbrushed patches, black bead eyes, pink stitched nose and mouth, original blue ribbon and tiny blank button –3in. (7.5cm.) long (slight discolouration to cream velvet, ribbon frayed)

- 12 A fine Steiff velvet rabbit rattle, circa 1908, with cream velvet with brown airbrushed patches, black boot button eyes with red felt backing, pink stitched nose and mouth, original blue ribbon with bell and tiny blank button –8in. (20cm.) long (slight discolouration to cream velvet, ribbon frayed)

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- 13 An early German velvet rabbit, 1905-10, with cream velvet with brown airbrushed patches, orange and black glass eyes, brown stitched nose and mouth and whiskers –5 ½in. (14cm.) long (slight discolouration to cream velvet)

- 14 A small early Steiff teddy bear, circa 1912, with dark golden mohair, black boot button eyes, pronounced clipped muzzle, black stitched nose, mouth and claws, swivel head, jointed elongated limbs with felt foot pads, inoperative side squeaker and underscore FF button to ear –8in. (20cm.) high (some thinning, small blad patch to back, slight stain to feet and back of head, a little squashed)

- 15 A rare Steiff white mohair Muzzle teddy bear, circa 1909, with black boot button eyes, pronounced clipped muzzle, brown stitched nose, mouth and claws, swivel head, jointed elongated limbs with felt pads, inoperative squeaker and brown leather muzzle with lead –9 ½in.(24cm.) high (thinning and bald areas mainly to upper body, left arm stitched in place at shoulder, stuffing settled to lower arms, hand pads replaced, some staining to foot pads)

- 16 A fine Steiff teddy bear, circa 1910, with golden mohair, black boot button eyes, pronounced clipped muzzle, black stitched nose, mouth and claws, swivel head, jointed elongated limbs with felt pads, inoperative squeaker, faded writing to right foot pad and hand knitted scarf –11 ½in. (29cm.) high (tiny hole to felt of right foot pad)

- 17 A rare small Steiff pull-along donkey, circa 1920, of grey felt, with black glass bead eyes, mohair mane, red felt saddle cloth with leather girth, and original leather collar, bell and pull cord and standing on metal frame with wooden eccentric wheels –4in. (10cm.) long (hole above left eye, muzzle, left shoulder and under side of belly, some nibbles)

- 18 A German wool plush sheep, circa 1910, with inset cream felt face, white boot eyes, brown stitched nose and mouth, felt ears, head slightly tilted to left, felt lower legs and squeaker –10 ½in. (26.5cm.) long (nibbled to felt nose, tiny hole to right front foot)

- 19 An early American teddy bear, circa 1915, with golden mohair, black boot button eyes, pronounced muzzle, black stitched nose, swivel head, jointed elongated arms, jointed legs and inoperative growler –12in. (30.5cm.) high (balding, right ear re-attached to side of head, stitched to left front shoulder, pads recovered)

- 20 An early German muzzled walking bear on wheels, with brown mohair, orange and black glass eyes, brown oil-cloth muzzle, ring through nose, painted black mouth, brown leather collar, fixed head turned slightly to left and on small cast iron spoked metal wheels –7 ¼in. (18.5cm.) long (loses to nose)

- 21 An early Steiff burlap elephant on wheels, circa 1908, with grey plush, black boot button eyes on pink felt backs, felt tusks, red felt saddle cloth and cast iron spoked wheels –8 ½in. (21.5cm.) high (some thinning, hole to left side of chest, hole to underside of trunk, hole stitched to rear left side, nibbled to saddle cloth)

- 22 An early German felt standing elephant, 1905-10, of cream felt with black boot button eyes, with wired limbs –9 ½in. (24cm.) long (hole to trunk with old stitch repairs, stitched to chest split to front right leg, holes to rear right leg, small hole to rear left underside of foot, with some nibbles)

- 23 A rare early Steiff tumbling elephant, possibly pre-button, of grey velvet, black bead eyes, raised trunk with bone tusks and turned wooden hemisphere base –6 ¾in. (17cm.) high (hole to underside of trunk, red cloth can be seen, small hole to left toe of seated leg, some discolouration to velvet, crack to underside of wooden hemisphere) - the Steiff Sortiment 1892 -1943 list that this toy was produced from 1901 until 1919

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- 24 A 1910/20s German clockwork polar bear, with white mohair, black boot button eyes, black stitched nose and mouth, clockwork mechanism with integral key and metal studs to base of feet –11in. (28cm.) long (some thinning to mohair, mainly around face, front left leg appears to have come away from mechanism, stitched from top of leg to underside of chest)

- 25 A rare mid 19th century German carved wooden menagerie, probably Sieffen, comprising two main buildings painted white with a floral frieze and two cage fronts, the roofs grey, backs pale orange stone with dark orange mortar, pale aubergine lower and black and white windows –12in. (30.5cm) wide, a similar giraffe house with pointed front (although giraffe is two tall!) and seven small animal houses, all with black painted cage fronts, a zoo keeper with red jacket and blue cap holding a whip and his other hand on hip (replaced base and repaired around waist), animals comprising an angry elephant with wrinkly legs –5 ½in. (14cm.) long (repaired break to trunk), a lion with head turned to right and long mane, a happy giraffe with circular spots, a polar bear (missing ear), a grey leopard and an orange leopard both with heads turned to the left and hair whiskers, a zebra, a hyena and an antelope, nine various birds, six trees (some damage to leaves), four fence sections and a gate - a handwritten note with this group 'Zoo given to C.C.B. by his grandmother Elizabeth Dyell? in 1868'

- 26 An 19th century skin covered nodding lion on wheels, with fur mane, glass eyes, opening mouth with milk glass teeth, whiskers and walking on grained wooden platform with cast-iron four spoked wheels –14in. (36cm.) long (some wear)

- 27 An 19th century skin covered nodding camel on wheels, with fur head, neck, hump and tail tip, glass eyes, pull-cord voice and walking on grained wooden platform with cast-iron four spoked wheels –14in. (36cm.) long (some wear and some repairs)

- 28 An 19th century skin covered nodding leopard on wheels, with glass eyes, opening mouth with milk glass teeth, whiskers and walking on grained wooden platform with cast-iron four spoked wheels –14in. (36cm.) long (some wear and two patched repairs arounds shoulders)

- 29 An 19th century skin covered nodding tiger on wheels, with glass eyes, opening mouth with milk glass teeth, whiskers and walking on grained wooden platform with cast-iron four spoked wheels –15in. (38cm.) long (some wear and missing tail)

- 30 A late 19th century fur polar bear on wheels, with orange glass eyes, brushed cotton legs, pull-cord voice and cast-brass wheels set into soles of feet –13in. (33cm.) long

- 31 A rare 19th century German birdcage squeak toy, the wood and wire cage with four colourful composition birds on branches with nest and foliage, squeak to base and pencil numbers to base –9 ½in. (24cm.) high (beak chipped)

- 32 An early 20th century Erzgebirge aviary, painted cream wood with red roof, printed paper trim, four birds with two branches and stamped Germany –1 ¾in. (4.5cm.) high (missing cage mesh)

- 33 A late 19th century Erzgebirge dog and kennel, painted white and black seated wooden dog with light brown kennel with red roof and brown and white floor –3 ¾in. (9.5cm.) long (small flake of paint missing from left side of dog)

- 34 A late 19th century Erzgebirge wooden dovecote, the base painted blue with white spots, cylindrical house and red pointed roof with ledges and four doves –5 ½in. (14cm.) high (missing dove from finial)

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- 35 A late 19th century Erzgebirge wooden pair of fighting cocks, painted white with speckled backs, one with red and black and the other with brown and orange stripes on wings and light brown painted base with red and green splotches —4 ½in. (11.5cm.) long

- 36 A late 19th century lead and tinplate bird whistle, a gold painted urn with 'B' in shield and whistle, possibly for water, a flat spring with red and green lacquer painted flying bird —5 ¾in. (14.5cm.) high

- 37 A group of early, 19th century German lead 'flats' wild animals, including an elephant —2in. (5cm.) long, a dromedary, a lion and a leopard, a fruit tree with snake, birds and red squirrel, a pair of storks and pair of peacocks with foliage and others, in a glazed display box

- 38 A Roulet & Decamps pouncing tiger automaton, circa 1900, fur covered carton body with black painted stripes, clear and black glass eyes with gold painted backs, keywind mechanism causing the tiger to walk along, move head from side to side and then leap and key —15in. (38cm.) long (tail coming away from body, slight general wear and fading)

- 39 A German painted tinplate well, circa 1900, painted red with yellow edge, impressed tile and brick, painted blue flower and two hand-cranked buckets on chain —11 ½in. (29.5cm.) high (slight wear)

- 40 An 19th century German figure of The Chocolate Girl after the painting by Jean-Etienne Liotard, probably a fine pottery or clay, holding a tray with milk glass cup and saucer, standing on tiled floor, in a glass dome —8in. (20.5cm.) high (chocolate pot replaced) - Meissen produced a similar figure around 1900

- 41 An 19th century German composition figure of a Welsh woman container, painted with card hat, removable head and turned wooden base —5in. (12.5cm.) high (chipped thumb)

- 42 An 19th century J Moore of Nottingham cut-paper silhouette of a boy with toy hoop, artist details on back of silhouette, inscribed on back 'John Jackson Ashworth taken 1850' and an indistinct old inscription 'Gorsefeted? Ircles? Old Road, Pendleton - Aged 8 years', framed —9in. (23cm.) x 7 ½in. (19cm.)

- 43 A mid 19th century Thüringen composition and wood kitchen mechanical toy, a ranged with hood one side, the other a yellow table, behind a rack with wooden plates and cups and milk glass jugs, a crank handle is turned and woman goes from table and turns and slides to rage, the floor painted yellow and paper walls, the outside of the wall painted stone and mounted on an orange box —5in. (13cm.) wide x 5 ¼in. (13.5cm.) high (missing arm, some wear and discolouration)

- 44 A doll's card hamper, circa 1900, with embossed wicker white card, hinged handle, a lid either end with a scrap of roses on each with pale blue ribbon fastening —4 ¾in. (12cm.) height to top of handle (creasing to handle, elastic loops to fasten perished)

- 45 An 19th century Frozen Charlotte in a walnut shell, with black painted hair and mauve silk dress, yellow silk bedding, inside of walnut shell painted yellow and fastening —1 ¾in. (4.5cm.) length of shell

- 46 An 19th century embroidered card sewing Valentine, white pierced card with blue stitched 'I Love You' and 'Forget Me Not' on either side, a blue silk pincushion lid, ribbon trim, a needle cloth inside and place to hold threads —2in. (5cm.) high

- 47 An 18th century pear shaped pin cushion, the three sides with different colour silk and a coiled metal thread flower with yellow, red and green glass bead petals, joined figure of eight metal trim and hanging loop —3 ¼in. (8cm.) high (one side with slight loss to silk)

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- 48 An early 19th or possibly late 18th century net drawstring purse, the four sections stitched together in green thread and heavily painted with grey scrolling foliage, pink silk ribbon drawstring and tassels —4 ¾in. (12cm.) long

- 49 A mid 19th century hand-painted and cut articulated paper doll, with brown eyes, black centre-parted hair in ringlets and bun at back, thread jointed at shoulders, hips and knees, painted black shoes with ankle laces, cream silk and net dress with ribbon at waist and holding a posy of flowers —11 ¾in. (30cm.) high; and recent frame

- 50 A rare 1830s French paper doll 'Le Trousseau de la Poupée', the paper doll printed on both sides with hand-colouring, the head turned to the right with brown eyes, brown centre parted hair, underclothes, slippers and holding a rose —10 ¼in. (26cm.) high with wooden base, two sided outfits comprising six dresses, six bonnets, five hairstyles with ornate accessories, a floral headband, five collars and three scarves, in original box with illustrated hand coloured lid showing three ladies, a girl and doll in front of a dressing table, small paper label to box base written in ink 'rykry' — sold at Lyon & Turnball, lot 442, 24th February 2022 from the estate of the late Mary Elizabeth Stuart Harley (1925-2019)

- 51 A mid 19th century George Wolfgang Faber 'Die Puppe des Madchen's' or 'The Girl's Doll' paper doll, printed on one side with hand colouring, the head tilted to the left, blonde hair, underclothes, orange slippers and holding a rose —6 ¾in. (17cm.) high, eight outfits with gloss finish including one holding a doll and another holding a spaniel, five with separate headdresses and one integral to costume, in original box with hand coloured illustrated lid (box sides taped, doll stitched repair at neck and hem, two outfits probably without headdresses)

- 52 A late 19th century German chromolithographic paper covered dolls' house set, with floral panels set in pale blue, white and black borders, comprising a sofa with purple velvet upholstery —5 ½in. (14cm.) wide, five chairs with purple upholstery, a mirrored cabinet, a mirrored chest of drawers, a cupboard with shelves above, a round and rectangular table

- 53 A rare late 19th century German painted tinplate nightlight, painted with wood grained finish, a glass pale paired with exotic bird and flower in ornate framed, a pierced balcony in front and curved ornate roof with finial, on a fluted column and circular base with drawer, a shelf behind glass to hold candle —14 ¾in. (37.5cm.) high (missing small piece of balcony and column leaning)

- 54 An early 19th century French card dolls' house Bonheur du Jour with shop stamp, covered in wood grained pair, with green paper shelf lining, embossed gilt paper trim, rams head and laurel leaf mouldings, mirror back of base and an indistinct oval ink stamp to base '.....ert & Bufer....(address) Paris'? —4 ½in. (11.5cm.) high

- 55 A late 19th century German chromolithographic paper covered dolls' house set with insects, floral decorated with a central outsized insect, comprising sofa with blue velvet upholstery —4in. (10cm.) wide, three chairs with blue velvet, a table and two cupboards, one with a clock, in mahogany case with front opening glass door —12 ¼in. (31cm.) wide

- 56 An early 19th century dolls' house card day bed, black painted with gilt lining and floral garland with red dot highlights, pink velvet upholstery with embossed gilt paper trim laid on card, possibly a sweet container —3in. (7.5cm.) long

- 57 An 19th century Erzgebirge dolls' house settee and four chairs, red painted wood with patterned upholstered seats —2 ½in. (6.5cm.) high

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- 58 A rare Bing Tripple-Trappel walking poodle, 1908 -1912, with white curly mohair, brown and black glass eyes, clipped muzzle, black stitched nose and mouth, metal lithographed tinplate disc on leather collar with leather lead and pull along walking mechanism –11in.(28cm.) long (some discolouration, brown stain to underside of tummy, metal rim to front right foot missing, slight thinning)

- 59 A small Steiff Molly dog, with brown tipped and white mohair, brown and black glass eyes, black stitched nose and mouth and swivel head –4 ½in. (10.5cm.)high (missing ears, missing an eye head loose, small hole wear back meets base); and a bull dog pin badge with RSPCA Animals Day card tag

- 60 A large English soft toy goose, 1920s, with grey mohair, clear and black glass eyes with remains of orange painted backs, yellow felt beak and jointed legs with webbed felt feet –12 ½in. (32cm.) high (some fading to mohair, hole and nibbles to felt of right leg, metal poking through at heal, two holes to underside of right foot)

- 61 An English white rabbit egg cosy, 1915/20s of white mohair, clear and black glass eyes, with remains of painted backs, red stitched nose and velvet lined ears –5in. (13cm.) high; a velvet snipe egg cosy with clear and black glass eyes, long tinplated orange bill, and a single rabbit mohair slipper (thinning to mohair, snipe cosy opening stitched together some fading; slipper missing an eye)

- 62 Three English bird egg cosies, 1910/20s, a velvet lovebird with orange head, yellow body and green wings, clear and black glass eyes with orange painted backs –4in. (10cm.) high; and two others possibly Snipes (one stitched at base, eyes missing, other with fading and lining faded)

- 63 Three English bird egg cosies, 1910/20s, a thrush with brown and black detailing and clear and black glass eyes (one missing), black painted beak, bright yellow satin lining – 3 ½in. (9cm.) high; and two others possibly Snipes (fading, one with small marks, possibly remains of old paint)

- 64 An early 20th century Steiff five-way jointed fox, with reddish brown and white mohair, clear and black glass eyes with brown backs, remains of black stitching to nose and mouth, black mohair edge to ears, swivel head, jointed legs and inoperative squeaker –10 ½in. (26.5cm.) long (thinning and wear, bald spots)

- 65 A Steiff St. Bernard dog on wheels, circa 1911, with white and red/brown mohair, clear and black glass eyes with painted dark orange backs, brown stitched nose, mouth and claws, brown leather collar impressed STEIFF, inoperative squeaker and cast iron spoked wheels –13 ¾in. (35cm.) long (some thinning and bald areas)

- 66 An early German teddy bear, 1910s, with blonde mohair, black boot button eyes, pronounced muzzle with black stitched nose, remains of mouth and foot claws, swivel head and elongated jointed limbs –12 ½in.(31.5cm.) high (thinning, bald around muzzle with small hole, pads recovered, some pink can be seen to mohair in joints possibly from an old outfit); and pale blue cotton top

- 67 A German sprung squeak teddy bear toy, circa 1920, with golden mohair, black boot button eyes, pronounced muzzle, black stitched nose and mouth, slotted in ears, large spring housed in body and stitched arms with felt pads –9in. (23cm.) high (some thinning, and bald spots)

- 68 A German sprung squeak teddy bear toy, circa 1920, with blonde mohair, black boot button eyes, pronounced muzzle, black stitched nose and mouth, slotted in ears, large spring housed in body and pin jointed arm with replacement pad –9in. (23cm.) high (worn, head incorrectly stitched to back of body)

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- 69 Two early 20th century teddy bears from Buxton, the larger, probably American with blonde mohair, black boot button eyes, pronounced muzzle, black stitched nose mouth and claws, cupped ears, swivel head, elongated limbs, inoperative growler and small hump –19 ½in. (49.5cm.) high (thinning and bald areas, hand pads recovered, right foot pad with holes left, stitched repair) and a smaller German blonde mohair teddy bear with clear glass eyes, swivel head and jointed limbs with felt pads (hand and foot pads with holes) - these bears were the childhood toys of the vet's wife in Buxton and bought directly from her and have always been together

(80cm.) total height of frame; and a photograph of a child seated on a grassy mound, a photograph of a child seated on a pull along bear with another holding a bike and another of a lady on a carousel horse marked 'Lascy' Isle of Man,

- 72 A small post-war Schuco yes/no teddy bear, with golden mohair, orange and black glass eyes, black stitched nose and mouth, orange bow sown to chest, metal framed jointed body and tail operated head mechanism –5in. (12.5cm.) high (very slight wear)

- 75 A small post-war Schuco yes/no teddy bear, with golden mohair, orange and black glass eyes, black stitched nose and mouth, orange bow sewn to chest, metal framed jointed body and tail operated head mechanism –5in. (12.5cm.) high (tail missing mohair covering)

- 76 Two post-war Schuco miniature animals, a blonde mohair rabbit with black pin eyes, red stitched nose and mouth, felt lined ear and metal framed jointed body in a knitted outfit –3 ½in. (9cm.) including ears; and a yes/no elephant (missing ears and tail covering)

- 77 Three post-war Schuco miniature teddy bears, with light brown/beige mohair, black boot button eyes, black stitched nose and mouth and metal framed jointed body –2 ¾in. (7cm.) high; a red brown bear (ear loose) and a panda (missing an arm)

- 78 Two post-war Schuco miniature animals, a Lady, from Lady and the Tramp with blonde mohair, black and white googly eyes, with metal eyelashes, black stitched nose and mouth, brown pipe cleaner ears, metal framed jointed body and brown collar –3 ¼in. (8.5cm.) high; and a cat (cat with replacement tail, top of metal body visible at neck, Lady tail with thinning)
